The Corporation is to be a membership organization whose purpose is to develop alumni support of Yorktown High School, its alumni, faculty and students thereby lessening the burden on government. It is anticipated that we will contribute funds to the public school, to augment equipment and supply budgets, help fund activities for needy students identified by the school, support the activities of the students through gifts to school clubs and after-school activities, including academic and sports programs. We will fund activities for which no funds are available, and supplement public funds. We are considering establishing a mentoring program matching alumni with students, to compliment the student's formal education, and so assist students in making career choices, and many other similar charitable activities. We will probably place ads in the student run newspaper to provide financial support for that program, awards from police stationed in the school (see Rev. Rul. 85-1, 1985-1 C.B. 177, and Rev. Rul. 74-246, 1974-2 C.B. 130), and generally work with the school staff to recognize former achievements and promote excellence amongst current students, faculty, alums and staff. We may fund continuing educational programs for staff when funds are not available or inadequate. We may fund a professional library for educators on subject matter of their choosing when public funds are unavailable or inadequate for this purpose. We hope to help instill individual and school pride by providing the personnel and financial support for such activities and augment public funds with private, and through in-kind donations.

We will provide the managerial support and direction in the organization and promotion of reunions, financial aid in support of special needs of the current faculty, and sponsorship of need, athletic, or merit-based students to attend college, sponsorship of career development programs for students, graduates and faculty, and such other activities in support of the school's alumni, faculty and students as shall be determined from time to time. All alumni, current and former faculty, parents and friends of same are, without regard to financial means, race, religion, national origin, or sexual orientation eligible to become members of, or participate in activities of, the corporation.

To accomplish the above purposes the Alumni & Friends of Yorktown High School , Inc provides the continuity, know-how, management and supervision of the programs mentioned above, to simplify such activities as the members thereof decide to pursue. Such support shall include, but not be limited to communications (publishing class lists, maintaining electronic mail addresses), data processing of financial and technical requirements, maintaining a database of former Yorktown students and faculty, graduates, and family and friends, fundraising and direct or indirect management of financial assets. If so determined by the membership, the corporation shall maintain a reference library consistent with the above purposes.

Initially, corporate activities will focus on creating the infrastructure necessary to carry out these charitable purposes. Creating of a master database is necessary for membership campaigns and fundraising campaigns. A mentoring program has to be supported by a means of identifying prospective mentors, and the capacity to communicate with them to publicize the need for mentors, etc. Accordingly, the attached budgets reflect the start-up phase of our activities where most of our efforts will be devoted to creating the institution which will undertake the type of activities discussed above. Accordingly, only the third year proposed budget reflects the beginnings of these charitable purposes, which will grow and diversify over time after the initial investment in infrastructure and corporate membership and publicity are firmly established.

Although assistance may be provided to support Yorktown athletic programs either with financial or logistical support, or both, we are not an qualified amateur sports organizations as defined by Sec. 501(j)2 of the I.R.C. because we do not offer athletic facilities or equipment and support local amateur athletic competition.

All such purposes shall at all times be exclusively for charitable purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, as recognized in Rev. Ruling 85-2, 1985-2 C.B. 178, as from time-to-time amended.

Funds are derived from dues, and such fund-raising activities as shall be approved from time-to-time by the Board of Directors. Such events may include, but not be limited to, clothing; and memorabilia sales, capital, scholarship and endowment campaigns, and reunions.

Form 1023, Statement II(3), page 2

It is anticipated that fund raising will be done by volunteer Yorktown Alumni, their parents and guardians, friends, neighbors, and current and former faculty without professional fund-raising aid. All fund raising activities conducted will benefit the organization and its members or Yorktown High School and its current or former faculty. Any surplus of fund raising proceeds will be carried over to the following year to enable continued support of a similar nature and pay other necessary expenses. One hundred percent (100%) of all funds raised, after expenses, shall be used to support the activities of the organization, the School and its faculty.

No officer or director receives any compensation for their services on behalf of Alumni & Friends of Yorktown High School , Inc. although reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses is anticipated when authorized by the Board of Directors.

Any individual, family member or interested person in the community desiring to secure admission to membership in the Corporation are required to complete and submit a membership application, and make timely payment of dues. It is anticipated that current and former faculty members, students and parents or guardians of current and former students, neighbors, and those interested in furthering the stated purpose of the corporation will be the members of the corporation.

We are still in the process of determining the most cost-effective manner to publicize the existence, purpose and goals of the corporation. We are investigating direct mailings, newsletters, a web site, electronic mail distribution lists, advertisements in school newspapers, and distribution of descriptive material to graduating students. Before seeking to recruit members from the general public, we anticipate focusing recruitment efforts on current and former Yorktown faculty, students and their families. Members from the general public, who express or have demonstrated interest in supporting the goals and objectives of our organization in support of Yorktown High School, are eligible to become members and assist in these and similar activities without regard to financial means, race, religion, national origin or sexual orientation.

No member of the corporation receives any direct benefits from our activities. The benefits we receive are indirect through the satisfaction of providing managerial, logistical and financial support for reunions, and newsletters to those with an interest in the graduates, faculty and families of those who have attended Yorktown High School. Additionally, we derive satisfaction from helping insure the continued excellence of the school, its faculty, and programs, and assisting in communication amongst and between our members and the school and by augmenting public budgets with the financial resources we contribute to the school. Through facilitating communications we add to the career satisfaction of Yorktown's professional staff through being able to stay informed of the successes and activities of the school's graduates, and, as determined by the Board from time to time, to provide a vehicle through which memorials, scholarships and honoraria may be solicited and administered. It is anticipated that we will engage in all permissible activities customary engaged in by private educational institutions and their alumni associations to support their school. Without the support to local government provided by our fundraising and logistical support, none of these activities would be undertaken to the considerable detriment of the community because of limited budgetary resources or conflicting priorities within the community which preclude adequate public funding of activities such as those discussed above. Thus we get the satisfaction of offsetting otherwise be government public functions, but which are beyond public budgetary and staffing abilities for such activities.
