We've created two merit-based scholarship funds for Yorktown students to help continue their education. Donations to the "Annual Scholarship Fund" will be invested until enough money is available to award a \$4,000 scholarship to a deserving Yorktown student; all donated monies will be used for this scholarship. When you donate to the "Endowed Scholarship Fund" the principal investment will remain untouched, and the invested earnings will be used to reward \$4000 scholarships to deserving Yorktown students.

Not only are donations to these two funds deductible, thousands of employers offer gift matching programs to enable you to stretch your donation even further.
